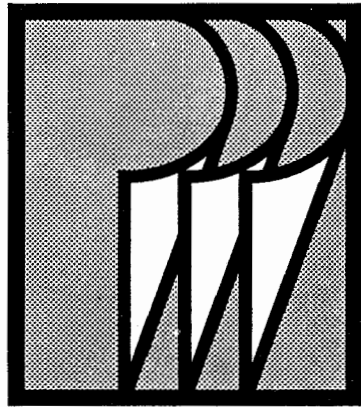

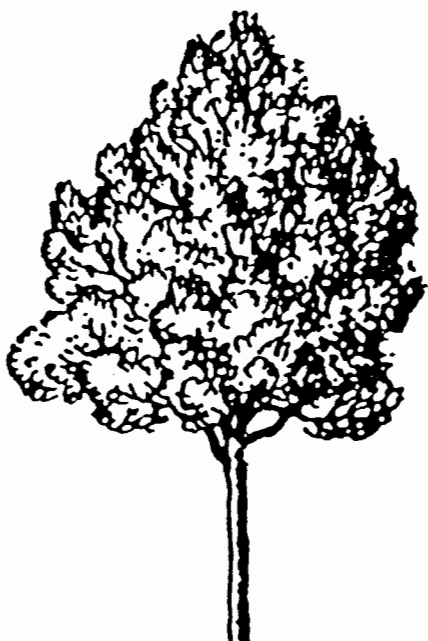

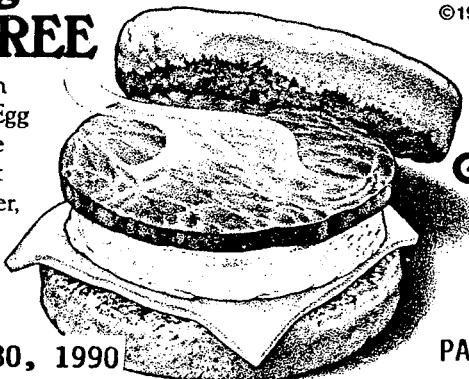

**BRENDA RUSSELL - Assistant Director:** Brenda has been assistant director for six musicals and plays in Payson and Provo (but worked on 11 productions) including 1776, Barnum, Brighton Beach Memoirs, Peter Pan, Shanandoah, A Funny Thing Happened On the Way to the Forum, Steel Magnolias, and Foreigner. She has also served as properties manager for many productions. She is the daughter of Manuel and Yvonne Russell, and has resided in Payson for over 18 years.

**ROBERT BIRD - Orchestra Director:** Bob has taught orchestra and band at Mountain View High School for ten years. He holds a Masters and Bachelor's degree in Music from BYU, and was awarded "Music Educator of the Year." He is presently working on his Ph.D. from the University of Arizona. Bob is a member of the National Band-Orchestra Panel of Outstanding Directors, National Association of Jazz Educators, and Utah Music Educators Association. He has led the orchestra for productions such as My Fair Lady; Bye, Bye Birdie; West Side Story; and Peter Pan. Bob and his wife Theresa have two sons, Mathew and Clayton.

**JUDY PORRAY - Miss Hannigan and Vocal Director:** Judy is a well-known character actress taking parts in Oklahoma, Peter Pan, Guys and Dolls, Fiddler, Annie, Barnum, Shanandoah, and Forum. 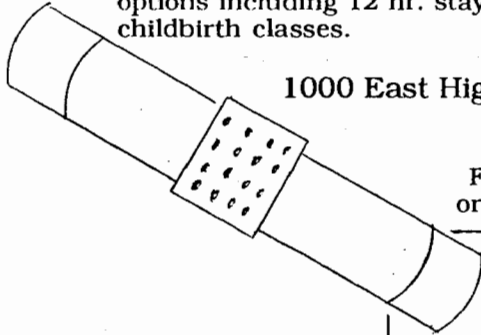
