Director's Note



The setting for the play is the Shenandoah Valley during the Civil War. Charlie Anderson, a widower and Virginia farmer, has six sons and a daughter and no slaves. He wants to mind his own business, to remain apart from the conflict between North and South. Most important of all, he wants to keep his sons out of the Confederate Army - even though the sons proclaim in a rousing song, "Next to Lovin', I Like Fightin' Best."

The Youngest son, Robert (The Boy) is kidnapped by marauding Union troops. Charlie, together with all his sons except James, whom he leaves behind with his wife and newborn baby, start off in search of the boy.

Shenandoah is a show about old fashion "American" virtues. A play on emotions of people yearning again, longing for a time of virtues and ideals. A dream that is proclaimed through the eyes of Charlie Anderson when he sings "Meditation" at his wife's grave.

Shenandoah presents a true and touching sincerity in many layers of feelings that strikes a universal chord of emotion and power in all of us.

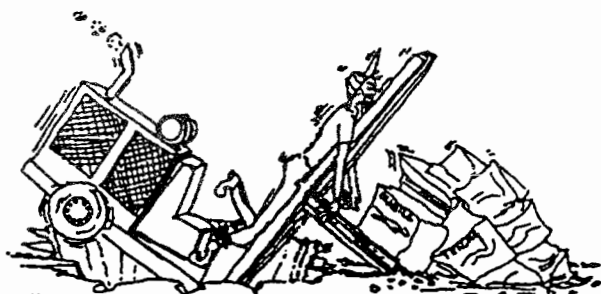
