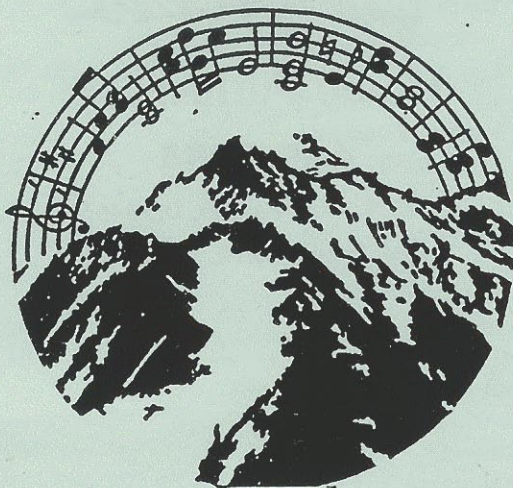

TERESA CHANG, Assistant Director. Teresa has cheerfully spent countless hours taking care of details for tonight's performance. An accomplished flute player, Teresa enjoys being actively involved in community concerns. She served as the PTA President last year, and while serving in this capacity initiated a fine arts program for Grant Elementary. Both she and her husband, Guy, are avid supporters of the arts. MARRINER BECKSTEAD, Vocal Director. After teaching for thirty years in Las Vegas, Nevada, Marriner recently joined the staff at Payson Junior High School, where he teaches band and chorus.
